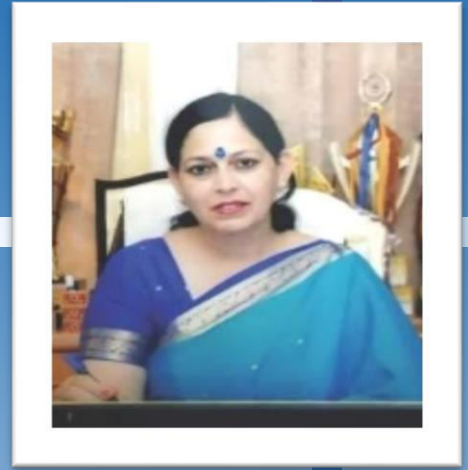

SVEEP ACTIVITY



The Political Science department in collaboration with Electoral Literacy club of the college organised SVEEP activities under which demonstration was given on VVPAT machine and EVMs to students.

The BLOs explained to students that Electronic Voting Machines has revolutionised the electoral system and introduction of Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) system has provided greater transparency to the poll process. It is voting using electronic means to either aid or take care of the chores of casting and counting votes. With the EVM, instead of issuing a ballot paper, the polling officer will press the Ballot Button which enables the voter to cast their vote. A list of candidate's names and symbols will be available on the machine with a blue button next to it. The voter can press the button next to the candidate's name they wish to vote for.

In another event, SVEEP pledge to cast vote was administered by the S. Harpal Singh (DEO), S. Kuldeep Singh Bajwa (SVEEP incharge & Principal Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Jura Chattra) and BLOs Sh. Sandeep Kumar, Sh. Vipin and S. Kulwinder Singh. S. Harpal Singh (DEO) also distributed voter cards to First time Voters in the college campus.

The students participated enthusiastically in these SVEEP activities.

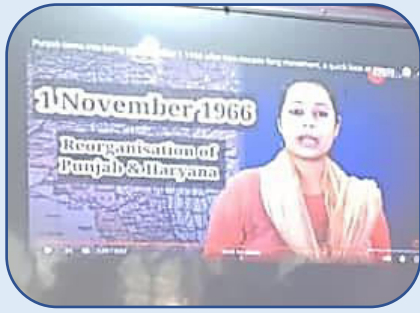

IMPORTANCE OF CONSTITUTION DAY IN INDIA

It is a matter of pride for all the Indians as 26th November is celebrated as Constitution Day. It is a day to honour the constitution of India. It is celebrated on the anniversary of signing and adoption of the constitution. To understand the importance of this day we must be aware about India's Constitutional history. Each and every country of the world is having one constitution. Jelinek said that a state without constitution would not be a state but regime of anarchy.

WHAT IS CONSTITUTION

- ❖ A constitution is a set of rules and regulations guiding the administration of a country.
- ❖ It is considered supreme law of the land. Indian constitution is a magnificent achievement of our founding fathers. It is the gift to successive generations of Indians' helping set up strong foundations for our country.
- ❖ It clarifies nature of the state.
- ❖ It provides knowledge about organs of government and its functions.
- ❖ It mentions rights and duties of the state.
- ❖ The preamble is the soul of Indian constitution which enshrines great values that will always remain our guiding light. From preamble we came to know the source of the constitution, Nature of Indian state and objectives of the Indian constitution.

JOURNEY OF THE MAKING OF INDIAN CONSTITUTION

It is the time to reflect on extraordinary journey of the Indian constitution's evolution. During british period, the system of India worked under the Act passed by British parliament. The last British Act was the Act of 1935. Before that in 1922 Mahatma Gandhi demanded that future of India should be determined by elected representatives of India. In 1934 Indian National Congress demanded that India should be given the right to make its constitution and constitutional Assembly be framed. Indian National Congress reiterated its demand from 1936 to 1940. In 1945 Lord Attlee sent his three-member commission to India. That Commission presented one report about elections to the Constituent Assembly. Then Elections were held in 1946.

MAKING OF THE CONSTITUTION

First Meeting of the Constituent Assembly was convened on 9th dec 1946. Dr. Rajendra Prasad was elected as chairman of the Constituent Assembly. Pt. J.L Nehru introduced 'Objective Resolution' which embodied those objectives on the basis of which constitution was to be framed. A seven-member Drafting Committee under the chairmanship of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was constituted on 29th Aug, 1947 to give proper shape to the constitution. Drafting Committee presented its report on Feb 21, 1948. Then National debate was held on Draft constitution. [2437 amendments]. Three readings were done from 4 Nov 1948 to 26 Nov 1949. It was on 26th Nov 1949 that Dr. Rajinder Prasad put his signature on Indian constitution. So, it took 2 years 11 months and 18 days to complete Indian Constitution. Total 11 sessions of the Constituent Assembly were held covering 165 days. It was written in two languages Hindi and English. Each page was decorated by the artists from Shanti Niketan including Ram Manohar Sinha and Nandlal Bose. Original copies are stored in special helium filled cases in library of parliament.

CELEBRATION OF CONSTITUTION DAY

In all these years the days was not popular but in 2015 on 11 October while laying the foundation stone of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's statue of Equality Memorial on 125th birth anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, Prime Minister N. Modi declared that every year 26th November would be celebrated as Samvidhan Divas or Constitutional Day. Prime Minister declared this day to honour the immense contribution of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in the making of Indian Constitution. While Signing the Constitution Dr. B.R. Ambedkar quote, "Let the consent of the people be the touchstone of constitution if we desire it should be worked. A constitution is only as good as those who work it. The success of the constitution depends upon the citizen of that state."

This Day is also dedicated to Draft Committee, Constituent Assembly, B.N Rao constitutional adviser, S.N. Mukherjee chief draftsman and artists who designed pages of the constitution.

ਮਹਾਂਪੁਰਸ਼ ਮਨੁੱਖਤਾ ਨੂੰ ਜਾਂ ਤਾਂ ਕਥਨੀ ਰਾਹੀਂ ਜਾਂ ਕਰਨੀ ਰਾਹੀਂ ਸੰਦੇਸ਼ ਦਿੰਦੇ ਹਨ । ਸ੍ਰੀ ਗੁਰੂ ਤੇਗ ਬਹਾਦਰ ਜੀ ਨੇ ਕਥਨੀ ਤੇ ਕਰਨੀ ਦੋਹਾਂ ਰਾਹੀਂ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਨੂੰ ਸੁੱਚਜੇ ਜੀਵਨ ਦੀ ਜਾਚ ਦੱਸੀ ਹੈ । ਜੇ ਕੁਝ ਗੁਰੂ ਜੀ ਨੇ ਆਪਣੀ ਬਾਣੀ ਵਿੱਚ ਕਿਹਾ ਹੈ, ਉਸ ਉਪਰ ਖੁਦ ਪੂਰੇ ਉਤਰ ਦੇ ਵਿਖਾਇਆ ਹੈ। ਦਰਅਸਲ ਗੁਰੂ ਘਰ ਦੀ ਵਡਿਰਮਾਈ ਹੀ ਇਹ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਕਰਨੀ ਤੋਂ ਸੱਖਣੀ ਕਥਨੀ ਨੂੰ ਪਾਖੰਡ ਕਹਿ ਕੇ ਫਿਟਕਾਰਿਆ ਹੈ । ਉਹਨਾਂ ਦੀ ਬਾਣੀ ਸੰਸਾਰ ਸਾਹਿਤ ਵਿੱਚ ਸੁੱਚੇ ਮੋਤੀਆਂ ਦੀ ਮਾਲਾ ਦਾ ਦਰਜਾ ਰੱਖਦੀ ਹੈ।

ਜਦੋਂ ਗੁਰੂ ਗ੍ਰੰਥ ਸਾਹਿਬ ਜੀ ਦੇ ਭੋਗ ਸਮੇਂ ਗੁਰੂ ਤੇਗ ਬਹਾਦਰ ਜੀ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਲਿਖੇ ਸ਼ਲੋਕ ਪੜ੍ਹੇ ਜਾਂਦੇ ਹਨ ਤਾਂ ਸਾਰੀ ਦੁਨੀਆਂ ਬਹੁਤ ਹੀ ਇਕਾਗਰ ਚਿੱਤ ਹੋ ਕੇ ਸ਼ਲੋਕ ਸੁਣਦੀ ਹੈ। ਇਹ ਬਾਣੀ ਮਨ ਦੀ ਮੈਲ ਨੂੰ ਹੁੰਝ ਕੇ ਬਾਹਰ ਸੁੱਟਦੀ ਹੈ ਅਤੇ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਨੂੰ ਚੰਗਿਆਈਆਂ ਅਪਣਉਣ ਦੀ ਪ੍ਰੇਰਨਾ ਦਿੰਦੀ ਹੈ।

ਸ੍ਰੀ ਗੁਰੂ ਗ੍ਰੰਥ ਸਾਹਿਬ ਵਿੱਚ ਗੁਰੂ ਤੇਗ ਬਹਾਦਰ ਜੀ ਦੇ ਸ਼ਲੋਕਾਂ ਤੋਂ ਇਲਾਵਾ ਉਹਨਾਂ ਦੇ 115 ਸ਼ਬਦ ਹੋਰ ਵੀ ਹਨ । ਸਮੂਹ ਸ਼ਬਦਾਂ ਅਤੇ ਸ਼ਲੋਕਾਂ ਵਿੱਚ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਨੂੰ ਦੁੱਖ- ਸੁਖ , ਉਸਤਤ - ਨਿੰਦਿਆ , ਮਾਨ ਅਪਮਾਨ ਅਤੇ ਗਰੀਬੀ - ਅਮੀਰੀ ਨੂੰ ਇੱਕੋ ਜਿਹੇ ਕਰਕੇ ਜਾਣਨ ਦਾ ਉਪਦੇਸ਼ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਗਿਆ ਹੈ। ਗੁਰੂ ਜੀ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਮਨੁੱਖਾ ਜਨਮ ਸਭ ਤੋਂ ਉੱਤਮ ਹੈ ਇਸਦਾ ਮਨੋਰਥ ਪ੍ਰਭੂ ਦੀ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤੀ ਹੈ, ਪਰ ਆਮ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਕੁਰਾਹੇ ਪੈ ਕੇ ਚੰਦ ਸੁਆਦਾਂ ਵਿੱਚ ਪੈ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਅਤੇ ਜ਼ਿੰਦਗੀ ਦਾ ਮਨੋਰਥ ਭੁੱਲ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ । ਉਹਨਾ ਨੇ ਸੁਆਦਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਤਿਆਗ ਕੇ ਹਰੀ ਸਿਮਰਨ ਦਾ ਰਸ ਅਪਨਾਉਣ ਲਈ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਨੂੰ ਵੰਗਾਰਿਆ ਹੈ। ਇਹ ਉਹ ਰਸ ਹੈ ਜੋ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤ ਹੋ ਜਾਣ ਨਾਲ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਦੇ ਅੰਦਰੋਂ ਕਾਮ, ਕ੍ਰੋਧ, ਲੋਭ, ਮੋਹ ਅਤੇ ਅਹੰਕਾਰ ਨਾ ਦੇ ਪੰਜ ਵਿਕਾਰ (ਚੋਰ) ਨੱਸ ਜਾਂਦੇ ਹਨ।

ਗੁਰੂ ਤੇਗ ਬਹਾਦਰ ਜੀ ਦੀ ਬਾਣੀ ਇਤਨੀ ਸਰਲ, ਸਪਸ਼ਟ ਅਤੇ ਮਨ ਨੂੰ ਮੋਹ ਲੈਣ ਵਾਲੀ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਇਸਦਾ ਇੱਕ - ਇੱਕ ਅਖਰ ਸੋਨੇ ਨਾਲ ਲਿਖਿਆ ਜਾਣ ਦੇ ਯੋਗ ਹੈ। ਗੁਰੂ ਤੇਗ ਬਹਾਦਰ ਜੀ ਦੀ ਬਾਣੀ ਪੜ੍ਹਿਆ ਪਤਾ ਲੱਗਦਾ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਆਪ ਜੀ ਦਾ ਜੀਵਨ ਵਧੇਰੇ ਵੈਰਾਗਮਈ ਸੀ ਪਰ ਉਹਨਾਂ ਦੀ ਇਹ ਗੱਲ ਤਾਂ ਨਿਸ਼ਚਿਤ ਸੀ ਕਿ ਦਰ ਆਇਆਂ ਦੀ ਬਾਂਹ ਹਰ ਹਾਲ ਵਿਚ ਫੜਨੀ ਚਾਹੀਦੀ ਹੈ। ਕੋਈ ਧੱਕੇ ਨਾਲ ਕਿਸੇ ਮਾੜੇ ਦਾ ਧਰਮ ਖੋਹਵੇ ਇਹ ਧਰਮ ਦੇ ਨਾਮ ਉੱਤੇ ਸਭ ਤੋਂ ਵੱਧ ਅਧਰਮ ਹੈ। ਇਸੇ ਲਈ ਹੀ ਉਹਨਾਂ ਨੂੰ 'ਹਿੰਦ ਦੀ ਚਾਦਰ' ਦਾ ਖਿਤਾਬ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਗਿਆ ।

ਉੱਤਮ ਬਾਣੀ ਦੇ ਕਰਤਾ ਗੁਰੂ ਤੇਗ ਬਹਾਦਰ ਜੀ ਨੇ ਜੇ ਕੁਝ ਕਿਹਾ ਉਸਨੂੰ ਆਪਣੇ ਜੀਵਨ ਵਿੱਚ ਅਪਣਾਅ ਕੇ ਦੱਸਿਆ ਉਹਨਾਂ ਨੇ ਉਪਦੇਸ਼ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਸੀ ਗਿਆਨੀ ਉਹ ਹੈ ਜੋ ਨਾ ਕਿਸੇ ਤੋਂ ਡਰਦਾ ਹੈ ਤੇ ਨਾ ਕਿਸੇ ਨੂੰ ਡਰਾਉਂਦਾ ਹੈ। ਆਪਣੀ ਜ਼ਿੰਦਗੀ ਵਿਚ ਵਿੱਚ ਸਮਾਂ ਆਉਣ ਉੱਤੇ ਆਪ ਨੇ ਇਸਦਾ ਅੱਖਰ - ਅੱਖਰ ਸਾਬਤ ਕਰ ਦਿਖਾਇਆ । ਔਰੰਗਜ਼ੇਬ ਦੇ ਤਸੀਹੇ ਸਤਿਗੁਰੂ ਜੀ ਦੇ ਮਨ ਨੂੰ ਡੁਲਾ ਨਾ ਸਕੇ ।

ਉਹਨਾਂ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਜੇ ਪੈਦਾ ਹੋਇਆ ਹੈ ਉਸਨੇ ਕਦੇ ਨਾ ਕਦੇ ਮੌਤ ਦੇ ਮੂੰਹ ਵਿਚ ਪੈਣ ਹੀ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਲਈ ਮੌਤ ਦਾ ਡਰ ਇਕ ਪਾਸੇ ਰੱਖ ਕੇ ਮਨੁੱਖ ਨੂੰ ਹਰੀ ਦੇ ਗੁਣ ਗਾਉਣੇ ਚਾਹੀਦੇ ਹਨ।
