




2. 5th August, 2023

The workshop emphasized interactive and engaging activities to explain complex concepts, making it easier to understand.

Regarding research proposal and report preparation, the workshop likely focused on simplifying these topics for learners. For research proposal preparation, they might have used examples and scenarios that are relatable to students' experiences, making the process more understandable. Similarly, for report preparation, they might have emphasized the importance of clear communication and organization, using storytelling or visual aids to illustrate key points. **70 students** and **4 faculty members** participated in this event.
