WORKSHOP ON CAREER OPPORTUNITY



Start up Cell of IIC organised a Workshop on 'Entrepreneurship and Innovation as a Career Opportunity'. Dr. Isha Kohli, Founder of Alphatoonz, Noida was the resource person. The event aimed to inspire and guide participants toward exploring entrepreneurship and innovation as viable career paths.
