The candidate will submit a hand written field work report showing photographs, sketches, observations, perspective of any topic related to Environment or Ecosystem. The exhaustive list for project report/area of study are given just for reference:

- Visit to a local area to document environmental assets: River / Forest/ Grassland / Hill / Mountain / Water body / Pond / Lake / Solid Waste Disposal / Water Treatment Plant / Wastewater Treatment Facility etc.
- 2. Visit to a local polluted site Urban / Rural / Industrial / Agricultural
- 3. Study of common plants, insects, birds
- 4. Study of tree in your areas with their botanical names and soil types
- 5. Study of birds and their nesting habits
- 6. Study of local pond in terms of wastewater inflow and water quality
- Study of industrial units in your area. Name of industry, type of industry, Size (Large, Medium or small scale)
- 8. Study of common disease in the village and basic data from community health centre
- 9. Adopt any five young plants and photograph its growth
- 10. Analyze the Total dissolved solids of ground water samples in your area.
- Study of Particulate Matter (PM<sub>2.5</sub> or PM<sub>10</sub>) data from Sameer website. Download from Play store.
- Perspective on any field on Environmental Studies with secondary data taken from Central Pollution Control Board, State Pollution Control Board, State Science & Technology Council etc.
