- Students sign declarations not to indulge in ragging.
- To sensitize students about the evils of ragging and its prohibition in the college during orientation programme

A meeting was held in the Principal's office on 20 July 2018. The following points were discussed in the meeting:


- To make students aware that ragging is illegal.






